Instructions

The pre-bankruptcy section of the questionnaire focuses on the time period from January 1 of this year up until the day before the day of your bankruptcy.

Why are we focusing on this period? When you file for bankruptcy, the Canada Revenue Agency requires **two** income tax returns for the tax year instead of the usual single return:

- The **pre-bankruptcy return**, which covers the period from January 1 until the day before the date of your bankruptcy.
- The **post-bankruptcy return**, which covers the rest of the year.

Let's start!

Step 1: Answer the questions that apply to you only. **This questionnaire may look long, but don't worry, many sections may not fit your situation. Just complete the parts that do. If something does not apply, it's okay to skip it!**

Step 2: When you're finished, save a copy of the questionnaire to your computer and upload it to your Supportal account. In addition, please upload any supporting documents or forms requested for the questions you answered.

Step 3 (optional): If you have not filed your income tax return for **last year**, please complete the prior-year questionnaire on **page 9** as well. Once we receive it and any required supporting documents, we'll use that information to file your return.
